Highlights

The GDP measured by the Expenditure Approach (GDP-E) is the sum of final expenditures on consumption, investments and net exports in the country. The GDP-E is published in nominal/current market prices and at constant prices with 2006 as the base year.

The growth rate for GDP-E for 2016 was 3.5% compared to 3.8% in 2015. This is consistent with the growth rate of 3.5% for GDP measured by the Production Approach.

The main contributors to the growth are as follows:

- 1. **Consumption Expenditure** grew by 2.6% in 2016 compared to 4.3% in 2015. The growth in consumption is explained by growth in households' final consumption expenditure of 1.7% and growth in final government Consumption Expenditure by 11.1%.
- 2. **Investment Expenditure** contracted by 13.1% in 2016 compared to a growth of 9.5% in 2015. The expansion in total investment is explained by contraction in Gross Capital Formation by 12.0% and a contraction in Changes in Stocks (reforestry, crude oil and livestck) of 31.0%.
- 3. **Net Exports of goods and services** expanded by 28.3% in 2016 compared with a contraction of 16.6% in 2015. The expansion in net export is explained by contraction in imports by 1.1% and expansion in exports by 5.9%.

NOTES:

- i. 2006 to 2015 estimates have been revised.
- ii. The GDP by Expenditure Approach is currently published annually.
- iii. The next wrevision will be carried out in September 2017
