Newsletter Producer Price Index (PPI) January, 2012



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Producer Price Inflation increased to 15.25 in January 2012

The Producer Price Index

The Producer Price Index (PPI) measures the average change over time in the prices received by domestic producers for the production of their goods and services. The PPI for Ghana reports the price indices with reference to September 2006, the base period. This release shows the producer price changes since September 2006, as well as the annual (year-on-year) and monthly inflation rates, for all industry and three major sub-sectors of industry (Mining and Quarrying, Manufacturing, and Utilities) for the last twelve months. The figures for the month of January 2012 are provisional, and are subject to revision in the release when additional data would be available. All other indicators are final.

January 2012 Producer Inflation

The producer price index increased 15.25 percent between January 2011 and January 2012 (year-on-year), representing an increase in producer inflation of 1.60 percentage points relative to the rate in December 2011 (13.65%). The month-on-month change in producer prices was 5.40 percent, after recording a decrease (-1.50%) in December 2011 (Table 1).

In January 2012, the producer price inflation in the mining and quarrying sector increased by 9.76 percentage points over the December 2011 rate of 18.23 percent, to record 27.99 percent. Manufacturing, which constitutes more than two-thirds of total industry, decreased marginally to 14.68 percent, from a rate of 15.25 percent in December 2011. The Utilities sector increased slightly by 0.25 percentage points from the December 2011 rate (9.07%) to record 9.33 in January, 2012 (Table 2)

Trends

During the 12-month period (January 2011 to January 2012), the all industry inflation rate rose steadily from January 2011 (20.85%) peaking in April 2011 (24.29%). It declined between May and June, and resumed the increase until September 2011 (19.59 %). The rate declined in October 2011, increased slightly in November 2011 recording a rate of 17.28 percent, but declined to record an end

of year rate of 13.65 percent. Beginning 2012, the rate increased to 15.65 percent in January 2012.

Manufacturing Sector

During the month of January 2012, six out of the sixteen major groups in the manufacturing sector recorded inflation rates higher than the sector average of 14.68 percent (Fig. 2). Manufacture of machinery and equipment n.e.c recorded the highest inflation rate (38.05%) whilst manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers recorded the lowest rate (2.33%).

Petroleum Price Index

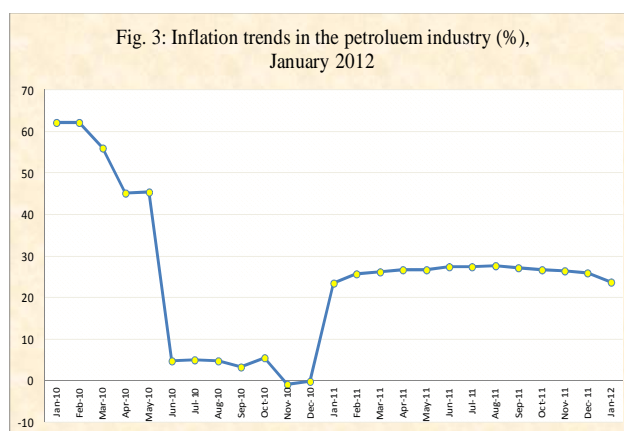
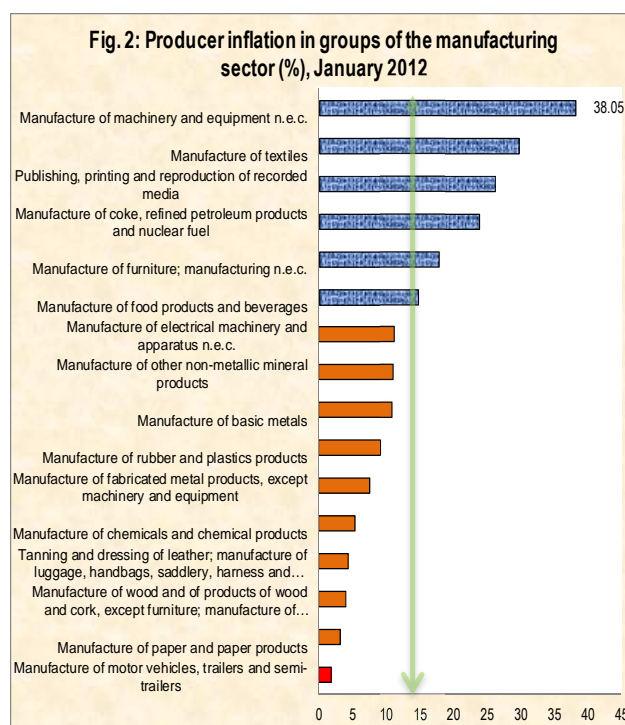
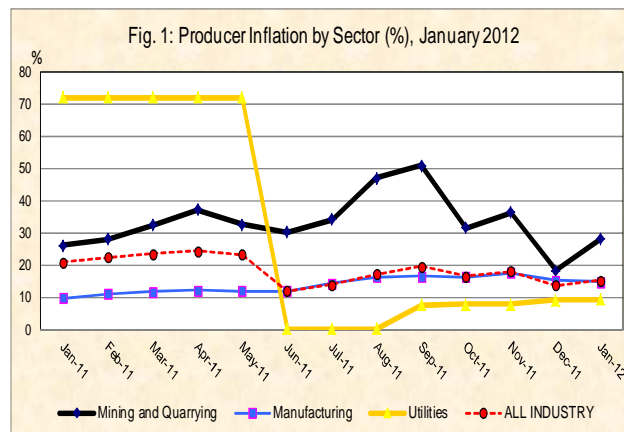
Over the last two years, inflation in the petroleum industry subgroup recorded three major significant changes in April 2010, June 2010, and January 2011. On the Average prices in the petroleum industry increase in January 2011 resulted in a sharp rise in inflation for this subgroup in January 2011 (23.39 %), and remained stable until December 2011. In January 2012, inflation in this group recorded a rate of 23.80 percent (Fig 3).

Highlights

The year-on-year producer inflation for all industry in January 2012 is 15.25%; the monthly rate is 5.40 percent.

Mining and Quarrying recorded the highest year-on-year producer inflation rate of 27.99%, followed by Manufacturing (14.68%). Utilities recorded the lowest rate of 9.33%.

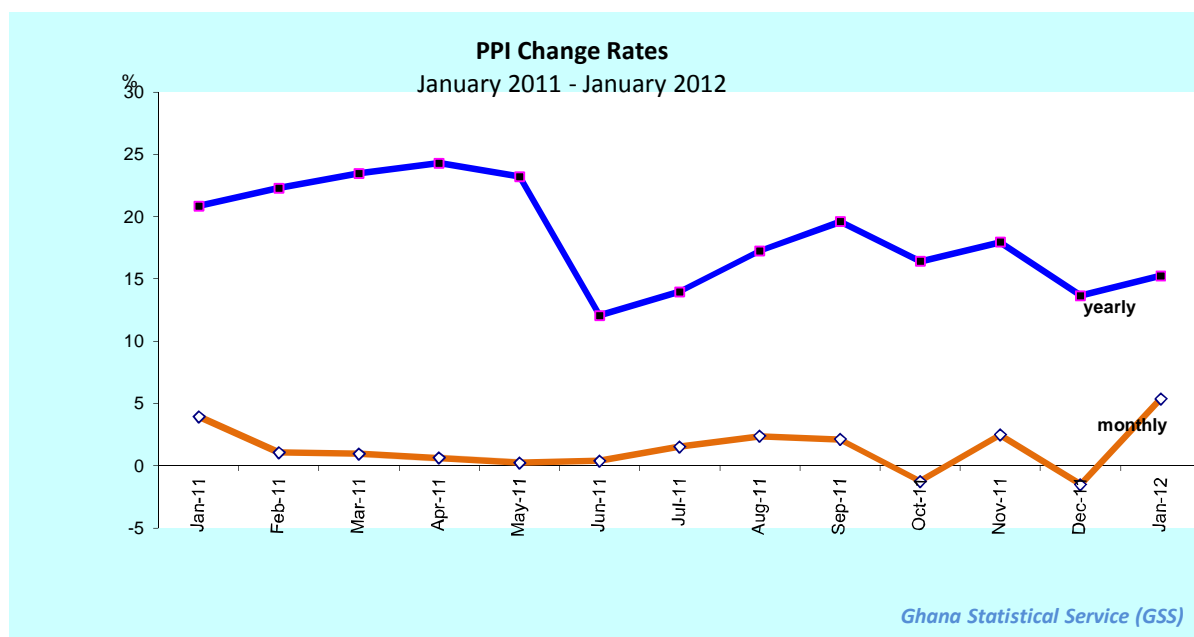
The monthly change rate indicated that Mining and Quarrying recorded the highest monthly rate of 7.84%, followed by Manufacturing (6.12%), and Utilities (0.25%).
