

193 countries have committed to Agenda 2030 + AAAA (Financing for Development).

How can we quickly get up to speed?

Agreed monitoring principles:

- Shall be country-owned take into account different national realities
- Track progress in implementing goals and targets, identify achievements, gaps and critical success factors
- Help mobilize necessary means of implementation and partnerships
- Shall be open, inclusive, and transparent for all people
- Shall build on existing processes, where these exist, avoid duplication
- Shall be rigorous and evidence-based, informed by country-led data




