

#### **HIGHLIGHTS FOR DECEMBER 2014**

#### Inflation Rate for December 2014 is 17.0%

The new Consumer Price Index (CPI) measures the change over time in the general price level of goods and services that households acquire for the purpose of consumption, with reference to the price level in 2012, the base year, which has an index of 100.

The year-on-year inflation rate as measured by the CPI stood at 17.0 percent in December 2014, the same as recorded in November 2014. This rate of inflation for December 2014 is the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) over the twelve-month period, from December 2013 to December 2014.



The monthly change rate for December 2014 was 1.0 percent compared to the 0.9 percent recorded for November 2014.

#### Food and non-food inflation for December 2014

The Food and non-alcoholic beverages group recorded a year-on-year inflation rate of 6.8 percent. This is 0.2 percentage points higher than the 6.6 percent recorded in November 2014.

Eight subgroups of the food and non-alcoholic beverages group recorded inflation rates higher than the group's average rate of 6.8 percent.

The non-food group recorded a year-on-year inflation rate of 23.9 percent in December 2014, compared to the 24.1 percent recorded in November 2014.

Two subgroups recorded year-on-year inflation rates higher than the group's average rate of 23.9 percent.

Housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels recorded the highest rate of 35.2 percent followed by Transport with 30.8 percent. Inflation was lowest in the Communication subgroup (12.8%).

## **Regional differentials**

At the regional level, the year-on-year inflation rate ranged from 13.6 percent in the Upper West Region to 19.0 percent in the Northern Region.

Four regions (Northern, Eastern, Central and Greater Accra) recorded inflation rates above the national average of 17.0 percent.






