Inflation Rate for January 2014 is 13.8%

The Consumer Price Index

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) measures the change over time in the general price level of goods and services that households acquire for the purpose of consumption, with reference to the price level in 2012, the base year, which has an index of 100.

January 2014 rate of inflation

The year-on-year inflation as measured by the CPI stood at 13.8 percent in January 2014, up from the 13.5 percent recorded in December 2013 (Table 1). This rate of inflation for January 2014 is the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) over the twelve-month period, from January 2013 to January 2014.

The monthly change rate for January 2014 was 3.9 percent, against the 1.0 per cent recorded in December 2013.


Food and non-food inflation

The **Food and non-alcoholic beverages** group recorded an average year-on-year inflation rate of 7.1 percent, 0.1 percentage points lower than the 7.2 percent recorded in December 2013. Four subgroups of the food and non-alcoholic beverages group recorded

The target publication date of the monthly CPI newsletter is the 15th of each month. It is released on the second Wednesday of each month, and on the third, when the 15th of the month falls on Wednesday. The next release date is 12th March 2014.

inflation rates above the group's average of 7.1 percent (Figure 1).


The non-food group recorded an average year-on-year inflation rate of 18.9 percent in January 2014, compared to a rate of 18.1 percent recorded in December 2013. Four subgroups recorded year-on-year inflation rates above the group's average rate (Figure 2). Housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels recorded the highest rate of 37.9 percent followed by Transport with 21.4 percent, Clothing and Footwear (20.2%), and Miscellaneous goods and services (19.3%). Inflation was lowest in the Communications subgroup (5.0%).

Regional differentials

At the regional level, the year-on-year inflation rate ranged from 10.5 percent in the Upper West region to 16.9 percent in the Ashanti Region. Three regions (Ashanti, Central, and Eastern) recorded inflation rates above the national average of 13.8 percent (Figure 3).


